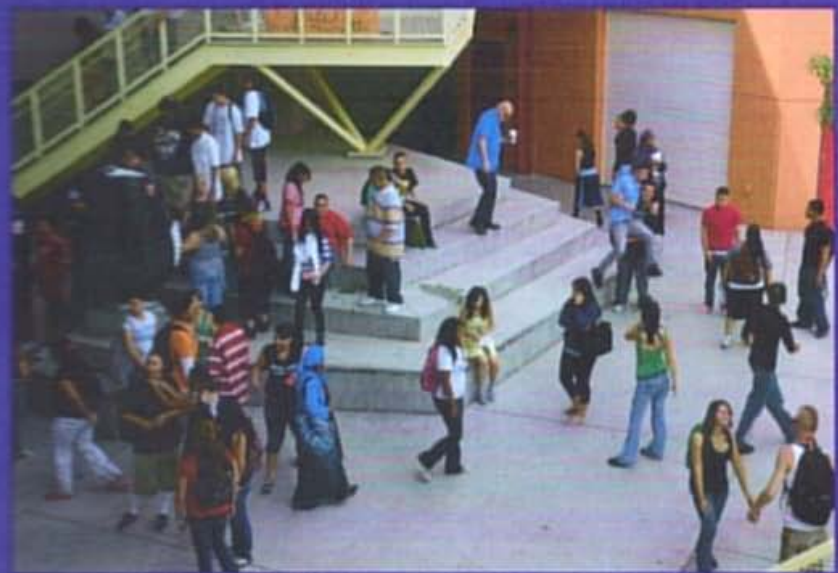
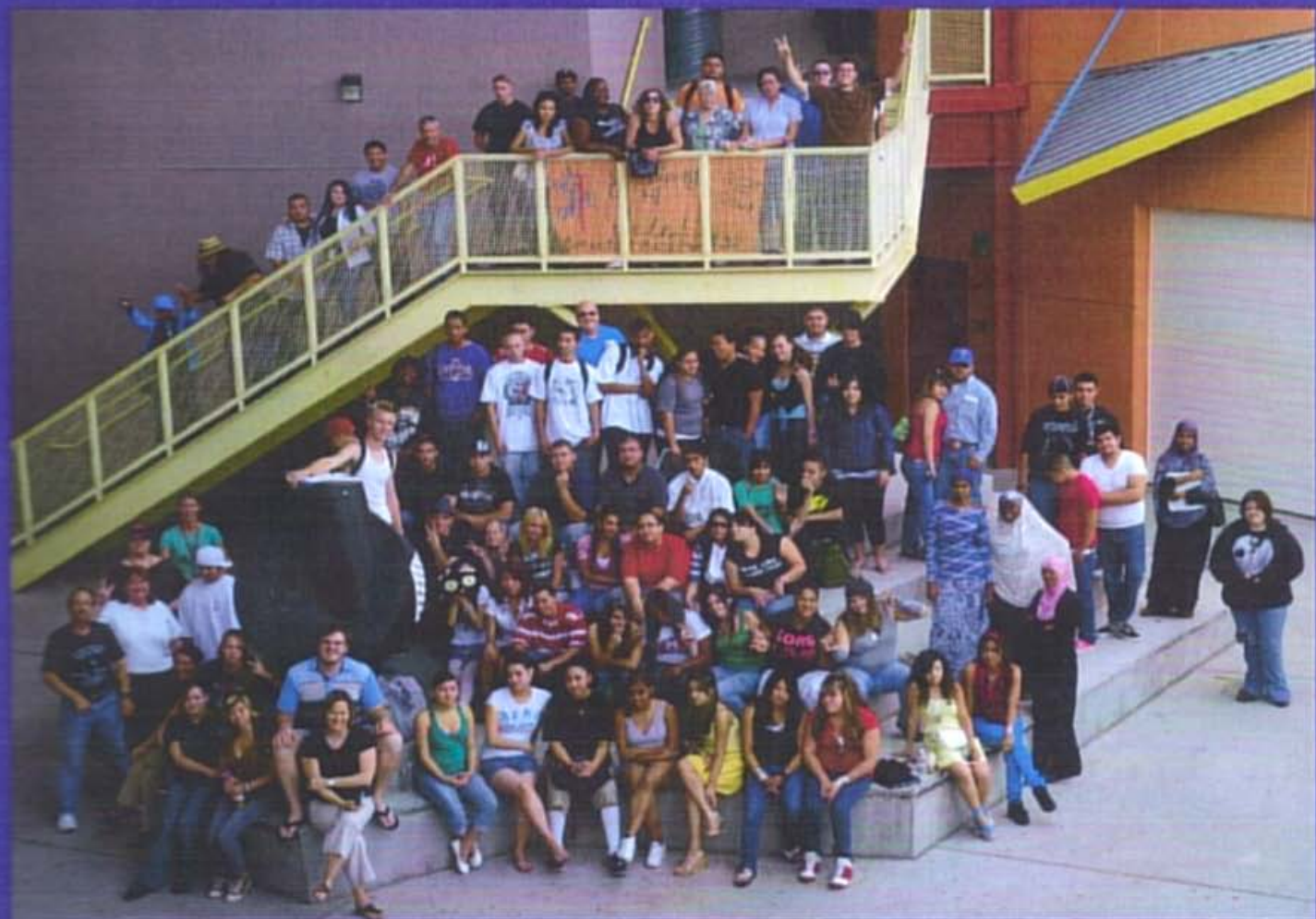
Project M.O.R.F. Mission Statement

Students work closely with their Advisors, and other academic teachers, in small teacher-to-student ratios.

Project M.O.R.F. 's student body is composed of students from all nine of the J.V.S.D. High Schools, as well as some students from other schools outside of District #1. We support and encourage a wide diversity of student enrollment, creating an interesting and talented cross-section of Tucson's population.

Project M.O.R.F. 's mission is to provide a supportive environment, where students develop academic mastery, generosity, independence, accountability and a sense of belonging. Special programs include some individualized instruction, Rock School Music Production and Recording Program, Computer Assisted Instruction, Future Builder and Home Building Vocational Programs, J.Y.P. (Talented Young People) Magazine and our Yearbook Production and Art and Photography Creation and Exhibition Opportunities, Mural Creation, Organic Gardening and Green School Opportunities and much, much M.O.R.F.

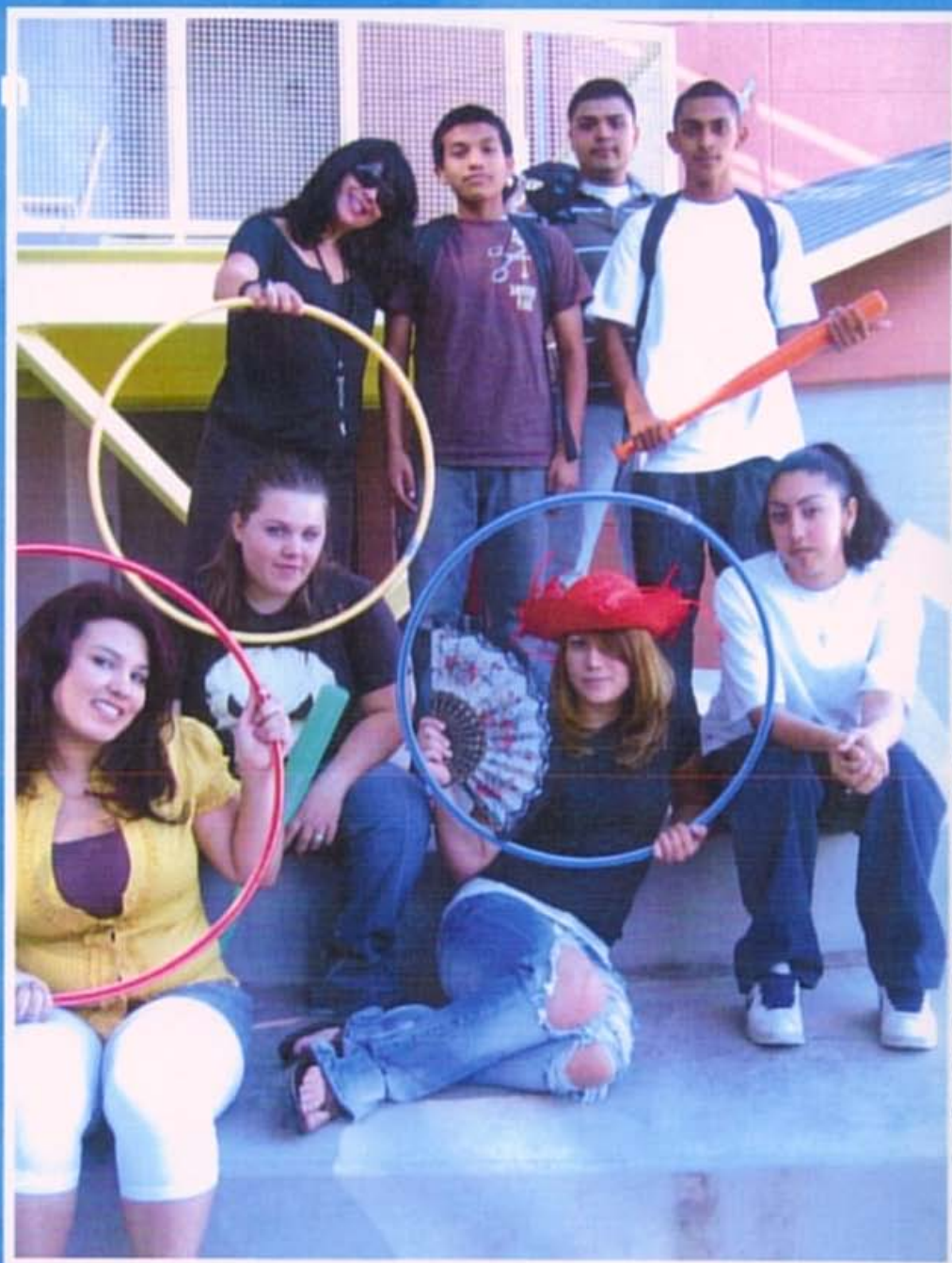

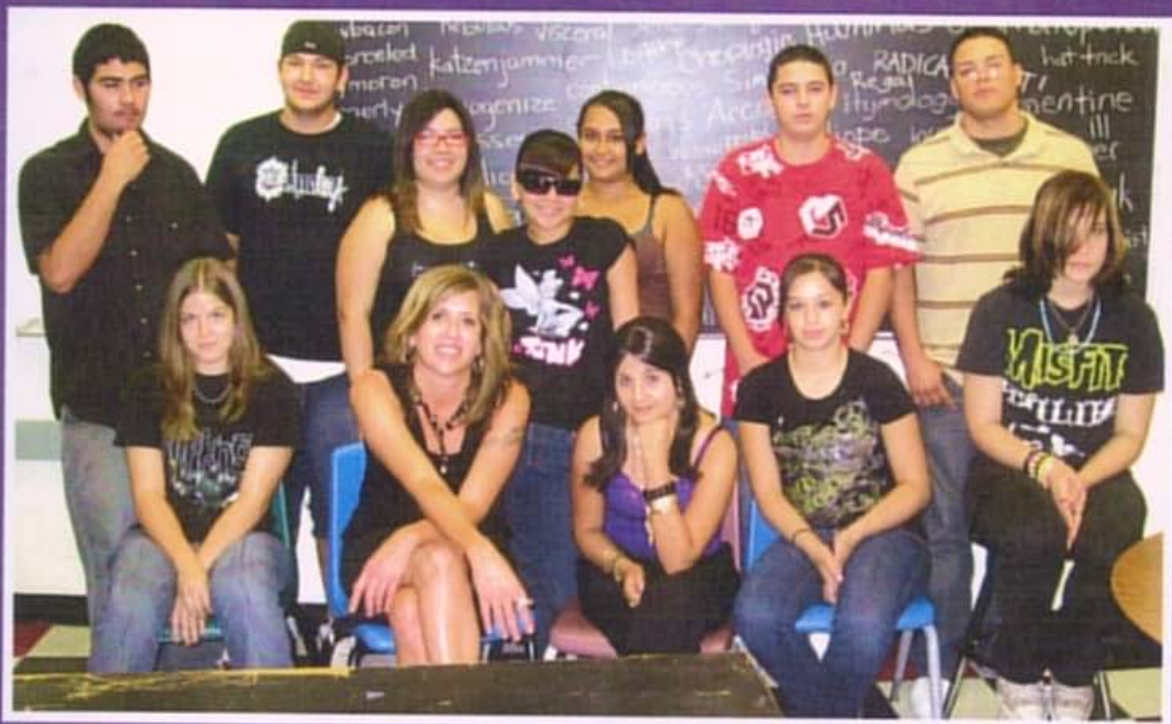
Aaron's Advising

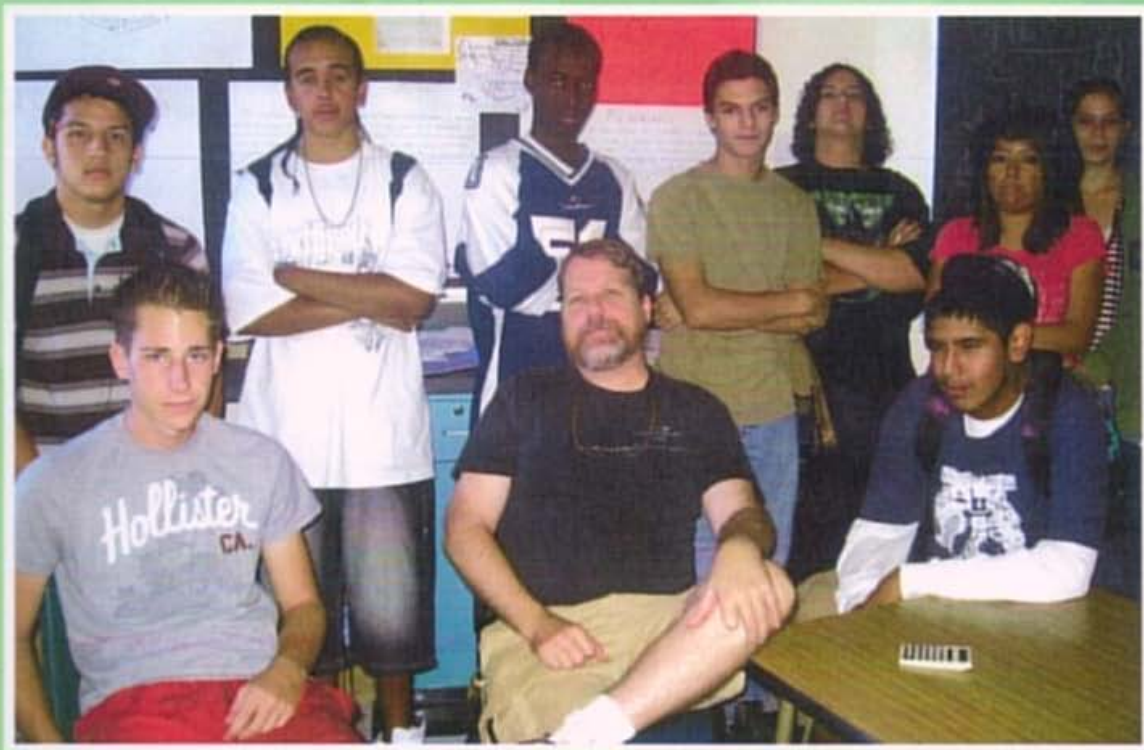

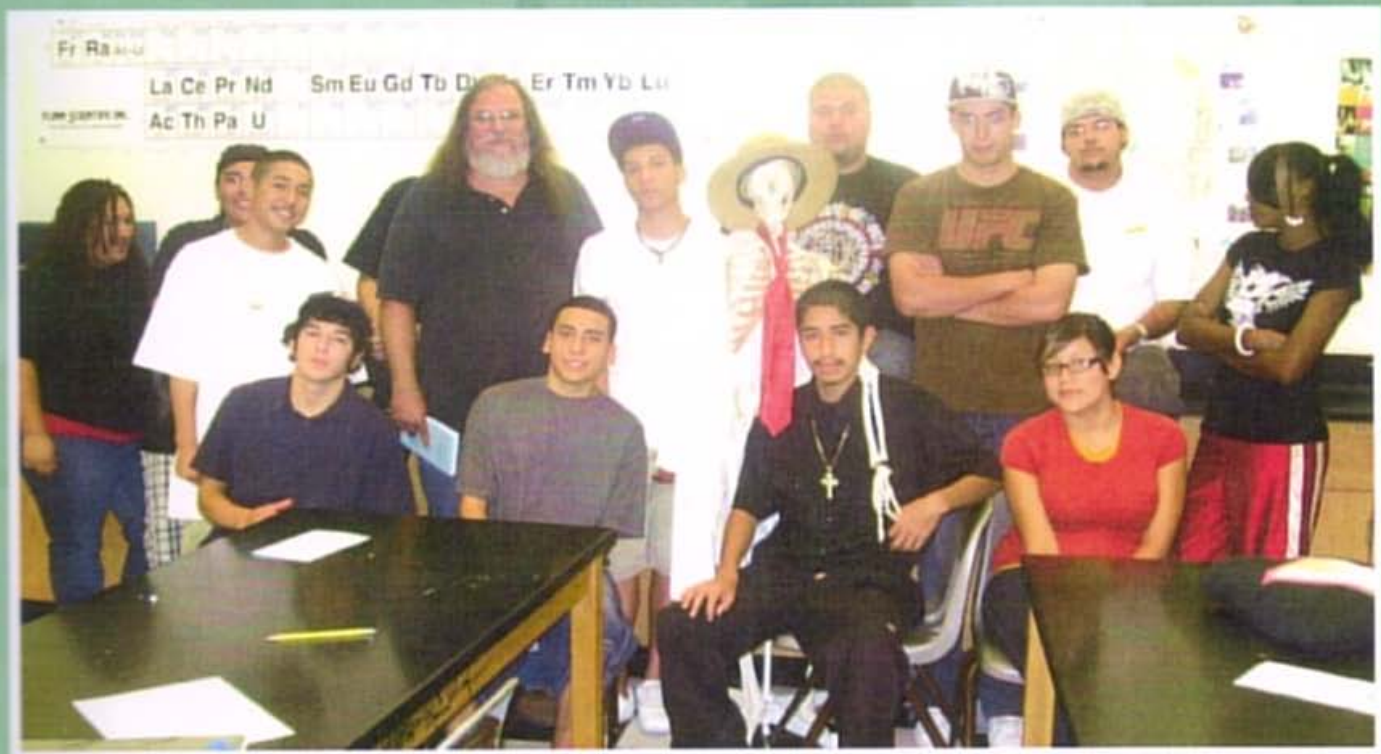


Her name says it all. Sunshine is probably one of the most pleasant people to be around, and truly makes learning algebra a blast.

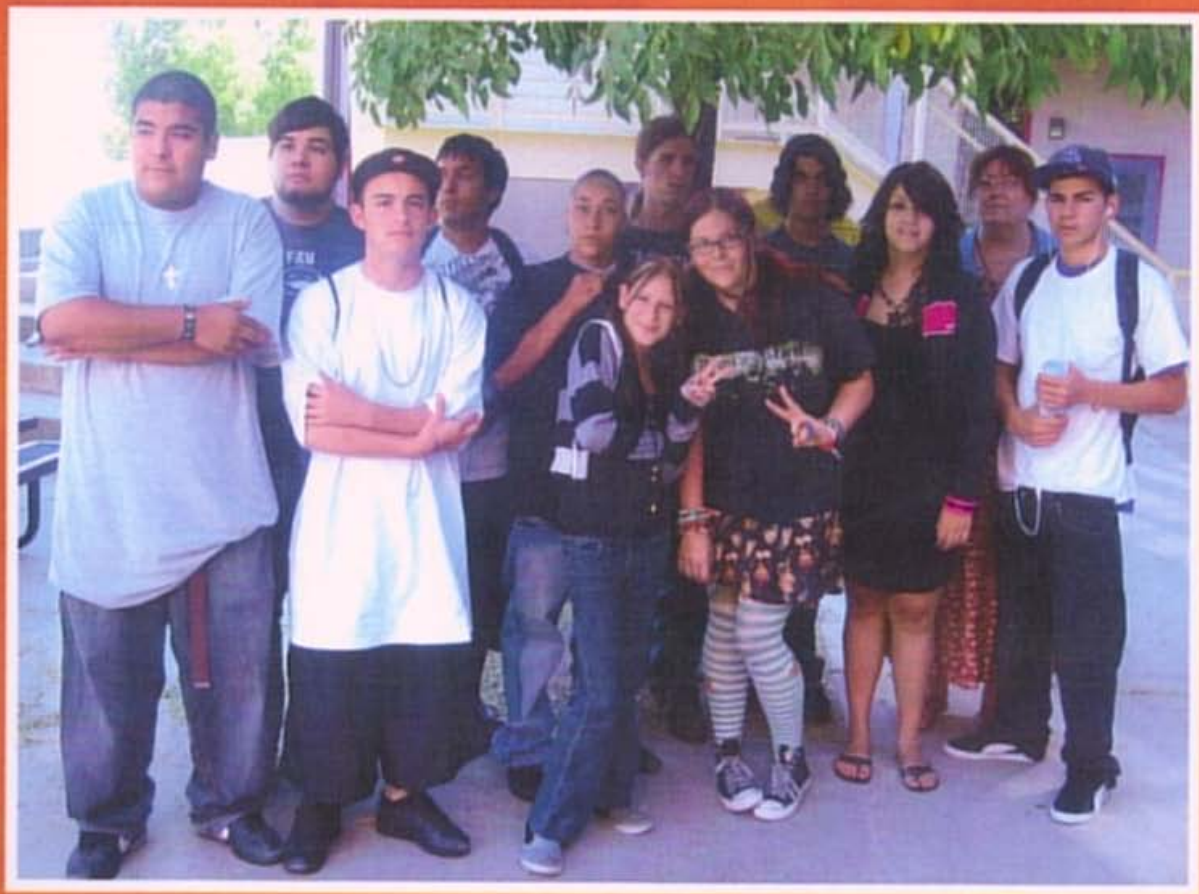


Have you ever hung out with a rock star?

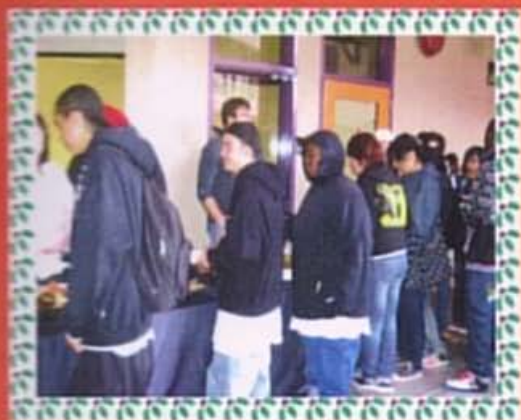
Holiday Feast

Alex: It's really hard to do and it's not working for me right now.

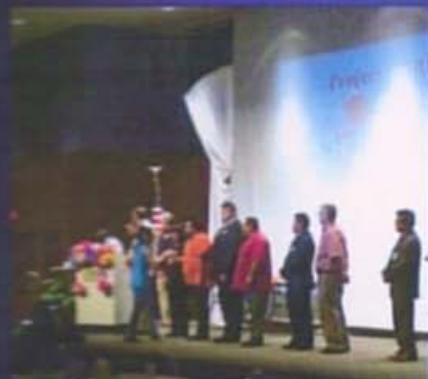
Courtney: What was your most memorable ride since you've been riding bulls?

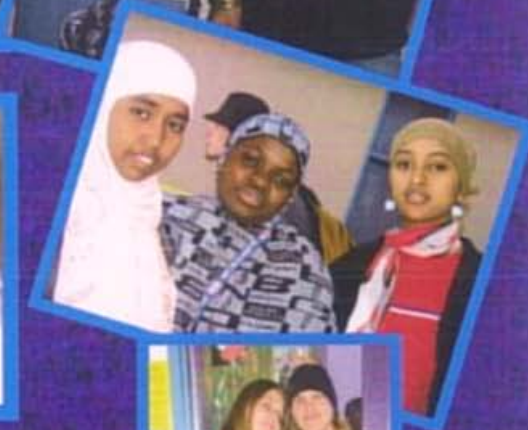
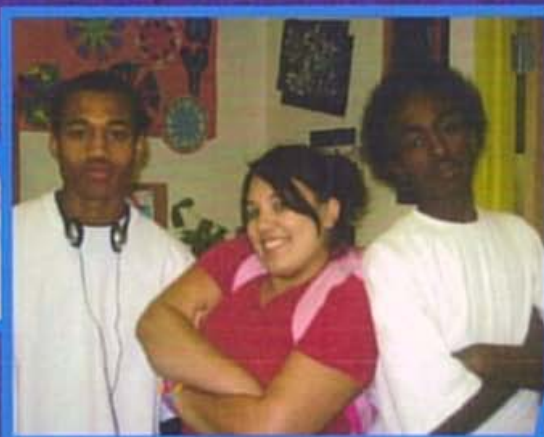
The TM technique is taught to new practitioners in a standardized, seven-step procedure, comprised of two introductory lectures, a personal interview, and a two-hour instruction session given on each of two consecutive days. Instruction begins with a short puja ceremony performed by the teacher, after which the student receives a mantra, learns the technique, and begins practicing. Subsequent sessions provide further clarification of correct practice, as well as more information about the TM technique.

Rock School started in 1985 when two students and I (Joe) wanted more time with music so we made up rock school. Originally we had Rock School two days a week.

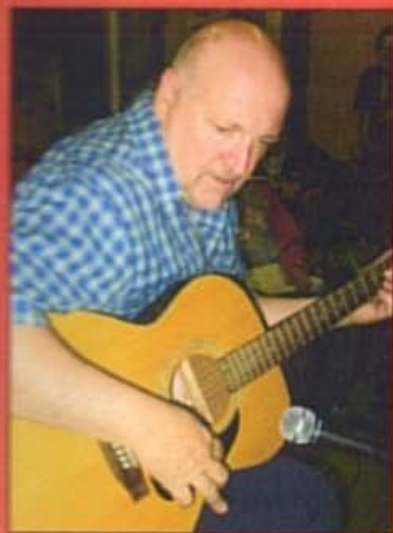
The object of Rock School was to help people learn music theory and improve on their skills (drums, guitar, keyboard, and vocals); and then we gave students the opportunity to perform.
