
Today computers effects us in everyday life; computers do almost everything for us.

Copper Queens, Iron Curtain, Vice Squad, TRDSaddletramps, and my personal favorite the Furious Truckstop Waitresses!

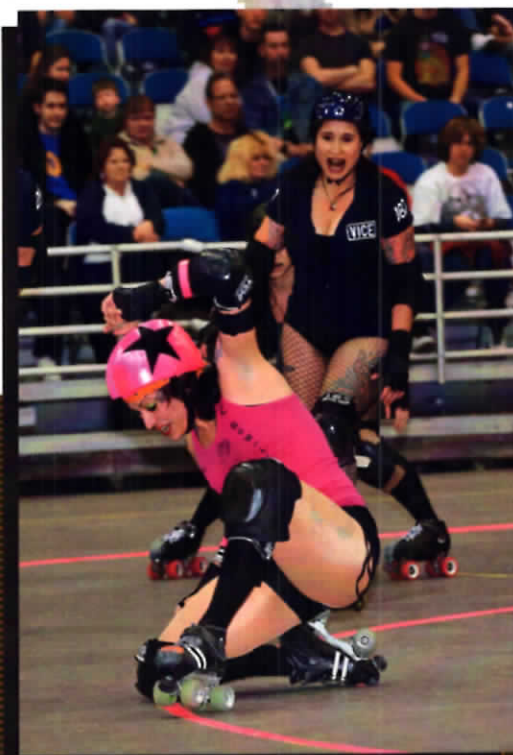
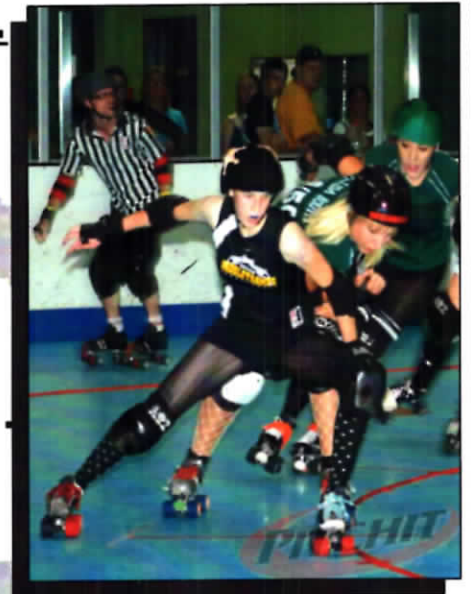
