What Can I Do to Help Someone Who May Be Suicidal?

(A Public Service Announcement by: <http://www.metanoia.org/suicide/whattodo.htm>)

1. Take it seriously.

"The people who talk about it don't do it." Studies have found that more than 75% of all completed suicides did things in the few weeks or months prior to their deaths to indicate to others that they were in deep despair. Anyone expressing suicidal feelings needs immediate attention.

"Anyone who tries to kill himself has got to be crazy." Perhaps 10% of all suicidal people are psychotic or have delusional beliefs about reality. Most suicidal people suffer from the recognized mental illness of depression; but many depressed people adequately manage their daily affairs. The absence of "craziness" does not mean the absence of suicide risk.

"Those problems weren't enough to commit suicide over," is often said by people who knew a completed suicide. You cannot assume that because you feel something is not worth being suicidal about, that the person you are with feels the same way. It is not how bad the problem is, but how badly it's hurting the person who has it.

2. Remember: suicidal behavior is a cry for help.

"If a someone is going to kill himself, nothing can stop him." The fact that a person is still alive is sufficient proof that part of him wants to remain alive. The suicidal person is ambivalent - part of him wants to live and part of him wants not so much death as he wants the pain to end. It is the part that wants to live that tells another "I feel suicidal." If a suicidal person turns to you it is likely that he believes that you are more caring, more informed about coping with misfortune, and more willing to protect his confidentiality. No matter how negative the manner and content of his talk, he is doing a positive thing and has a positive view of you.

3. Be willing to give and get help sooner rather than later.

Suicide prevention is not a last minute activity. All textbooks on depression say it should be reached as soon as possible. Unfortunately, suicidal people are afraid that trying to get help may bring them more pain: being told they are stupid, foolish, sinful, or manipulative; rejection; punishment; suspension from school or job; written records of their condition; or involuntary commitment. You need to do everything you can to reduce pain, rather than increase or prolong it. Constructively involving yourself on the side of life as early as possible will reduce the risk of suicide.

4. Listen.

Give the person every opportunity to unburden his troubles and ventilate his feelings. You don't need to say much and there are no magic words. If you are concerned, your voice and manner will show it. Give him relief from being alone with his pain; let him know you are glad he turned to you. Patience, sympathy, acceptance. Avoid arguments and advice giving.

5. Urge professional help.

Persistence and patience may be needed to seek, engage and continue with as many options as possible. In any referral situation, let the person know you care and want to maintain contact.

Project 28



The Bush Administration has asked Congress to approve \$400 million to be used in the creation of a 670-mile-long fence along the southwestern border. The already half built fence will be financed with \$400 million that were set aside for surveillance technology projects for the Mexican border. Government investigators say that this will not be enough to finish the construction by the end of this year because of higher prices for fuel, steel and labor. Jayson Ahern, the deputy commissioner of Customs and Border Protection says, "If we run out of money, unfortunately the construction will have to stop." The fence is not intended to stop illegal immigration completely, but to make it more difficult for immigrants to enter the country illegally. The entire plan includes more border patrol officers, an enforcement of immigration laws, a physical fence and a high-tech fence with surveillance technology consisting of sensors, cameras, and radar. The high-tech fence will be more difficult to construct after the 28-mile fence that was built south of Tucson was said to have failed by the Bush Administration. The Government Accountability Office (GAO) blames the Department of Homeland Security for the delay in construction, stating that failure to complete the fence is "not a technical issue, it's an acquisition-management issue." The director of Homeland Security, Richard Stana, responded by saying DHS did not set "performance standards" for Project 28. Along with the shortage of revenue, DHS has other obstacles in its way before the completion of the fence. More than 240 condemnations have been filed, of which 100 filed have been approved. The Justice Department has also filed some condemnation in counties where tracking the land owners and/or their attorneys became unsuccessful. U.S. Democrat Representative Raul Grijalva says, "This whole fence, virtual or otherwise, is becoming the biggest waste." Condemnation: U.S. Law, the seizure, as of property, for public use.

Not only will both the physical and high-tech fence be a waste of money, it'll also be a waste of time and resources. The southern border that spans 1,952 miles, has only a physical barrier of 190 miles and a vehicular barrier of 154.3 miles. With over 32 border cities used for illegal crossing, immigrants looking to cross the border won't have difficulty picking a starting point.

The flight that hit the Pentagon hit it at 535 M.P.H. The flames were so strong that the fire ricocheted off the buildings— they were like fire balls, crashing 310 feet into the building . That's why so many people were killed or hurt on September 11, 2001. To this day many people are still recovering.





